

Local Track & Field Volunteer to Represent ME at National Competition

The Maine Association of United States Track & Field (USATF) is pleased to announce that Lee Jackson of Old Town has been named one of 10 winners of the prestigious Ludus Tours grant.

These grants were awarded by the USATF to a select group of applicants after an intensive review process.

Lee is one of two recipients chosen to represent the state of Maine as an official at the 49th USATF National Junior Olympic Track & Field Championships in Jacksonville, Florida. The championships will take place July 27- August 2, 2015 at University of North Florida's Hodges Stadium.

When asked about the grant, Jackson responded "It's an honor to be chosen as a grant recipient. I look forward to travelling down to Florida to represent Old Town and the state of Maine. It says a great deal about our state program that two of the ten officials selected are from Maine. This wouldn't have been possible without my family, friends, and the support of Maine's track community."
